Thank you for enrolling in Summer 2020 Mini Camp.

We are looking forward to resuming in person classes. Now more than ever it is extremely important that you review the policies and procedures.

When you enrolled online, you had to provide your mobile phone number, the name and phone number of an emergency contact, and allergy information.

The last page of this document is a waiver that must be signed and returned on the first day of class. If you cannot print the waiver to bring with you, we will have printed copies available on the first day of class to sign.

If there is anything else that we need to know about your student, especially as it relates to health issues, please be sure to reply to this email after reading the attached pages.

Our Box Office is open from 11 am to 4 pm for phone calls at 732-528-9211. If you need to reach the theatre in an emergency situation, please try the Box Office first, followed by calling 732-528-4336 for our administrative office.

Please note that due to the fact we are in an evolving situation, policies and procedures are subject to change at any time. If you have any questions or feedback, please contact us.

COVID-19 POLICIES & PROCEDURES

ASSUMPTION OF RISK & LIABILITY WAIVER

Algonquin Arts Theatre has put in place policies & procedures designed to reduce the spread of COVID-19, however we cannot guarantee that your child will not become ill and participation in camp could increase your risk of contracting COVID-19. As such, Algonquin Arts Theatre must receive a signed liability waiver upon arrival for the first day of camp.

MASKS / FACE COVERINGS

Because we are an indoor camp, all students will be required to wear a mask or gaiter face covering through the class session. All staff are required to wear masks.

CLASS SIZE

We are limiting classes to 12 students. There will be no more than 2 teaching artists/ administrators present in the classroom (usually it will be just 1)

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Classes will all take place on our stage. Students will be assigned a 'home' area during each class week to keep any personal materials in this space. Students will be required to stay six feet apart at all times when outside their 'home' space.

MEDICAL CHECK

Before class, we request that parents screen their student(s) for temperature and any symptoms of illness. Any student with any illness symptom (related to COVID-19 or not) should stay home. A pro-rated credit is available for classes missed due to illness.

If staff members detect any symptoms, a student will immediately be isolated away from the class and we will call the parents/emergency contact.

QUARANTINE

The following is established based on CDC guidelines and NJ State Regulations. A student must withdraw from class (full or pro-rated refund available) in the following circumstances:

- Traveled to a state required to quarantine within 14 days of beginning a class session.
- Been exposed to an individual who is confirmed or assumed to have COVID-19 within 14 days of the start of class must withdraw.
- Has tested positive, or had any of the symptoms of COVID-19, unless: 3 days with no fever **AND** no respiratory impact **AND** at least 10 days since symptoms first appeared.

CANCELATION

Summer Mini Camp is subject to cancellation at any time by Algonquin Arts Theatre, with our without direction from public health officials, during this uncertain period. A full or pro-rated refund would be provided for canceled classes.

GENERAL POLICY & PROCEDURES

ARRIVAL

All students will enter via the East Stage Door. This green door is located just to the left of our administrative offices and marquee when in the parking lot. Our teachers will prop open this door when class is open for students. The door will open approximately 10 minutes before class begins. No before care is available. Upon arrival, students should utilize hand sanitizer or our lobby restrooms to clean hands.

DISMISSAL

Our instructors will make their best efforts to dismiss the class promptly at the end of the allotted time. When picking up, please be mindful of social-distancing best practices. Because you will likely be within six feet of other families, we ask that you wear a mask when you leave your vehicle in the Algonquin's parking lot. In nice weather, students will be permitted to wait outside the stage door. In rainy weather, parents should come in through the stage door once it opens to pick up. There is no after care for students. Please be prompt as there will be no one here to stay late at the theatre with your child. Any parent more than 15 minutes late will be charged subject to an additional fee.

EARLY DISMISSAL

If you are picking your child up early for any reason, please send a note to the instructor with your child. When arriving for early pickup, please knock on the stage door and our teacher will open it for you.

LATE ARRIVAL

If you are planning to be late, notify the instructor via note on the day prior. If your student arrives late for unplanned reasons, please help them enter through the stage door where they can enter class late.

MISSED CLASSES

If you have a planned absence, please send a note to the teacher or email our Box Office at boxoffice@algonquinarts.org. There is no refund or credit for missed classes, unless due to illness or quarantine due to COVID-19 exposure.

BREAK TIME

All classes and workshops will be given a short break. Students have access to using the restrooms and a period of time to have a small snack. At no time will students be permitted to leave the Algonquin Arts Theatre building without being released to a parent.

FOOD & DRINK

Algonquin Arts Theatre will not be able to provide food or drink to students.

- All students should bring a water bottle labeled with their name. Please no sugary drinks (juice, isotonic, etc) unless required for medical reasons.
- Students who wish to have a snack during break time can bring small, self-contained, prepackaged snack items (i.e. a granola bar, snack pouch).
- Students will be instructed to wash hands prior to snack time.

FINAL CLASS PRESENTATIONS

Each class will have a final class presentation. This presentation will begin 15 minutes prior to the end of the final day of class. Each student may have 1 parent or guest attend and record video of the presentation. All guests must wear a mask and practice social distancing. We will provide details on entering / exiting the theatre. If noted in the class description, Algonquin Arts Theatre may also be distributing media of the final performance.

CLOTHING RECOMMENDATIONS

Due to the nature of the exercises and activities, proper clothing and shoe attire is mandatory. Please make sure that your child is prepared for class in clothes that will allow them to move around freely. Students should wear clothes that will allow them to be comfortable in full range of motion. For safety and comfort, we recommended NOT wearing skirts or dresses (unless shorts or leggings are worn underneath) or loose jewelry. Closed-toe sneakers, stage shoes or dance shoes must be worn. Students will not be able to participate in flip-flops, crocs, sandals or Uggs.

CELL PHONES & USE OF TECHNOLOGY

Cell phones, tablets, laptops, i-pods and/or any other electrical devices are not permitted for use in the classroom. If you send your child to class with a cell phone, please be sure to have them turn it off or silenced until class dismissal. Use of cell phones or any electrical devices in the classroom will result in confiscation until the end of day. Algonquin Arts Theatre is not responsible for the claim of lost or stolen items. Leave it at home! Students don't need anything but themselves to participate in our classes.

LOST & FOUND

AAT is not responsible for replacing lost or misplaced items, so we recommend you bring only essential items to class or rehearsal. Please leave all valuables at home. Items left at AAT will be kept in lost and found but will be disposed of after 30-days without claim. CANCELATION OR CHANGE IN SCHEDULE

Announcements regarding a change in the schedule will be made via email. This is the fastest way to get the message out. We will additionally reach you using the contact information you have provided at the start of the class. In a case of poor weather, please make your best judgment regarding these circumstances. Again, we will do our best to reschedule, or tack on time to upcoming classes to make-up for the loss of classroom time.

MISS OR DROPPED CLASS

There are no refunds for having missed class unless for medical reasons. No refunds after the first day of class. AAT understands that not every class is suited for every student. Call us, we want this to be a good experience for your child. There may be an option to switch to another class. In a non-preventative situation, we are willing to offer a credit or full refund on a class, as long as you keep in communication with AAT regarding your attendance situation.

ACTS OF GOD

No one person will be liable for failure to appear, present, teach or perform in the event that such failure is caused by the physical disability of the personnel, or acts or regulations of public authorities, labor difficulties, civil tumult, strike, epidemic, tornado, earthquake, interruption or delay of transportation service or any other cause beyond the control of any party. In such a case, all parties will make their best efforts to reschedule the engagement.
